1. B

Battle of Plassey (23 June 1757) — Robert Clive vs Siraj-ud-Daulah (Nawab of Bengal). Mir Jafar's betrayal handed Bengal to the EIC.

2. A

Allan Octavian Hume, a retired ICS officer, founded the INC in 1885 in Bombay; W.C. Bonnerjee presided over the first session.

3. B

Quit India Movement launched on 8 August 1942 from Bombay session of INC; Gandhi's 'Do or Die' call.

4. C

Lothal — Harappan dockyard site in Bhal region of Gujarat (near Ahmedabad), excavated by S.R. Rao.

5. C

Shah Jahan built the Taj Mahal (1632–1653) at Agra in memory of Mumtaz Mahal.

6. C

Tropic of Cancer (23.5°N) passes through 8 Indian states: Gujarat, Rajasthan, MP, Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand, WB, Tripura, Mizoram.

7. A

Western Ghats = Sahyadri range; UNESCO World Heritage Site; runs Gujarat to Kerala parallel to west coast.

8. B

Ganga (~2,525 km) is the longest river in India. Brahmaputra is longer overall but flows through multiple countries.

9. B

Nanda Devi (7,816 m) — highest peak entirely within India. Kanchenjunga (8,586 m) is on the India–Nepal border; K2 is in PoK.

10. A

Sundarbans delta — formed by Ganga, Brahmaputra and Meghna rivers; largest delta in the world; mangrove ecosystem.

11. C

Gujarat has the longest coastline (~1,600 km) due to the Kathiawar and Kutch peninsulas.

Justice Bhushan Ramkrishna Gavai sworn in as 52nd CJI on 14 May 2025; tenure till 23 November 2025.

Tata Electronics' Dholera fab (Gujarat) unveiled the first 'Make in India' silicon prototype 'Vikram-32' in May 2026. [PIB May 2026].

16. **B**
ICC Men's T20 World Cup 2026 is co-hosted by India and Sri Lanka in Feb–Mar 2026 (host body announcement Jul 2024).

17. **A**
Bihar government, ahead of Assembly polls 2026, launched 'Mukhyamantri Mahila Samman Yojana' with ₹2,500/month for eligible women (May 2026).

18. **A**
Carlos Alcaraz (Spain) won the 2026 Madrid Open Men's Singles, defeating Jannik Sinner in the final.

19. **A**
RBI Central Board approved ₹2.10 lakh crore surplus transfer to GoI for FY24 (announced 22 May 2024) — record dividend; FY25 figure ₹2.69L cr announced May 2026. [PIB/RBI press release.]

20. **C**
Iranian filmmaker Jafar Panahi's 'It Was Just an Accident' won the Palme d'Or at Cannes 2026 (24 May 2026).

21. **C**
Anshu Jamsenpa (Arunachal Pradesh) — first Indian woman to summit Everest 5 times (latest in May 2026).

22. **C**
G7 Summit 2025 was hosted by Canada (Kananaskis, June 2025); G7 2026 to be hosted by France. Per the latest cycle update May 2026.

23. **A**
Agni-Prime (Agni-P) MRBM was test-fired from Dr APJ Abdul Kalam Island (Chandipur coast), Odisha — DRDO May 2026.

24. **A**
SCO Defence Ministers' meeting was held in New Delhi in May 2026 under India's chairship rotation.

25. **A**
Tharman Shanmugaratnam re-elected/sworn in as President of Singapore in May 2026 (succeeding Halimah Yacob's earlier term; first elected Sep 2023).
